# Co-Principal Investigator Donna Brogan, PhD

Dr. Donna Brogan has worked in sample survey design and analysis for over 40 years. She has over 130 publications, including book chapters on analysis of sample survey data using appropriate software, methodological research in sample survey design and analysis, and collaborative research with health scientists in multiple disciplines. She collaborated over many years with Dr. Nancy Kutner and other colleagues on research in end stage renal disease. Most of her research has been funded by NIH.

Dr. Brogan has conducted over 100 continuing education (CE) courses for over 2500

participants on analysis of data from health sample surveys. She continues to give CE courses after her retirement as Professor of Biostatistics from Emory University in 2004.

Dr. Brogan frequently served as a scientific advisor to federal and state government and other health research organizations. She has evaluated research proposals for almost every federal health agency, particularly NIH. She has provided consultation on both the design and analysis of several health sample surveys, including BRFSS, PRAMS, studies of persons with a specific diagnosis (e.g. HIV/AIDS, cancer, and end stage renal disease), and international health studies. She has consulted on analytical strategies for many additional surveys, including NHANES, NHIS, and YRBS.
