Your child, NAME, is participating in the Diabetes Autoimmunity Study in the Young (DAISY) and the Celiac Disease Autoimmunity Research study (CEDAR). DAISY and CEDAR are studies conducted by the University of Colorado School of Medicine. The purpose of these studies are to identify children who are at higher than average risk of developing Type I diabetes and/or celiac disease and then follow them forward in time to try to understand both the genetic and environmental causes of these diseases. NAME was invited to participate in the study because he/she is related to your other DAISY participant DAISYNAME, who we screened at birth and found to be at increased risk for Type 1 diabetes or celiac disease. When NAME was seen in the DAISY clinic on DATE a sample of blood was collected, with your consent, and sent to a laboratory to test for 'diabetes and celiac disease gene markers'.

This letter is to inform you that based on the genetic screening, NAME is at increased risk for Type 1 diabetes or celiac disease. This does not guarantee that he/she will not develop diabetes or celiac disease; it means that he/she is at no more risk than the average child. Although he/she is at increased risk of diabetes or celiac disease, this does not mean that he/she will definitely develop the disease.

If you wish, you may take this letter to your pediatrician to notify him/her of these results.
