Roche Resends

Samples are resent if Roche was unable to type the original sample or if we have reason to question the result given. A list of samples to resend is generated each time that new results are imported.

- 1. Prepare Resend samples before sending out new NEC and NOC samples
- 2. Label 2mL cryovials with the assigned Roche ID numbers and the initials of the DAISY subject.
- 3. Locate the cord blood whole blood samples in the lab refrigerator (the list gives the box and row numbers).
- 4. Transfer 0.5mL of blood from the original sample tube to another tube with the Roche ID.
- 5. Put the remaining whole blood sample back in its original location.
- 6. Put the Resend samples with the Roche Resend box located in the lab refrigerator, and record the Roche ID and initials of the subject in the Roche Resend Excel file.
- 7. The Data Manager will receive the results from Roche and will update them to the database.
