DAISY Study: \$50 Dollar Re-engagement Visit

Criteria for Receiving \$50 Dollars

- Participant has not been seen for at least two years from the date of the scheduled visit
- **AND** Must be an enrolled participant
 - DAISY cohort (NEC, NOC, SOC, CNEC)
 - **OR** FAM cohort with **Study Subject** Relationship (FAMRELN)
- AND complete a blood draw during their scheduled clinic visit
 - Participants on the Long Distance Protocol are qualified for the \$50 dollar reimbursement ONLY if they complete a blood draw and annual interview
 - Filter paper subjects do not qualify unless they are willing to complete a blood draw
- The \$50 Reimbursement is a **ONE-TIME PAYMENT** and cannot be combined with any other DAISY retention offers
- The \$50 Re-engagement Visit protocol will end on August 2016
 - Last day to schedule the re-engagement visit is on 8/31/2016
 - Eligible for \$50 if scheduled by/on 8/31/2016 even if visit occurs after 8/31/2016
 - If the post 8/31/2016 visit is canceled or no-show, the \$50 offer is no longer available and they will receive \$20 for the clinic visit

Procedure

- When making scheduling calls, the scheduler will check in the DAISY database to see if a participant is eligible for a re-engagement visit
 - Visit type=LTF for those whose enrollment status is "Enr lost to follow up"
 - Visit type=Every year for those whose enrollment status is "Surveillance"
- After a participant meets the criteria **AND** schedules an appointment to come in, the scheduler will notify the clinician who is seeing the participant
- Before the visit, the clinician will get \$50 dollars from the DAISY Petty Cash Custodian
- Clinic Visit
 - Obtain current DAISY consent (CEDAR consent no longer included as of Sept. 1, 2016)
 - FFQ's will not be sent prior to visit, it can be completed during the visit, if participant agrees
 - Complete as much of the DAISY protocol as the participant agrees to, including blood draw, other biological specimen collection, and Annual Update Interview
 - Upon completion of the visit please ask if we may contact them in one year (or sooner if Ab results are positive) to attempt to schedule a visit (re-enroll) or obtain outcome information (surveillance). Please note this at the bottom of the clinic visit form (reenroll or surveillance).
- During the visit, the clinician must explain why the participant gets \$50 reimbursement and the next time they come in for a clinic visit, they will only be reimbursed \$20 dollars
- At the end of the visit, the clinician will label the receipt as a "Re-Engagement Visit" and have the participant initial the receipt, confirming they received payment
- Clinician will give receipt back to the Petty Cash Custodian for storage
- When the Petty Cash custodian runs the query in the DAISY access database to update that all participants have been paid for the specific time period, she will update the \$50 dollar amount for the Re-Engagement Visit.
