# CLINIC VISIT Summary

## A. Preparation for Clinic Visit

Prior to a child's clinic visit reminder calls need to be made to the family and the child's chart needs to be prepared for the visit. Chart preparation includes making sure that Clinic Visit sheets are printed out for each family member that we would like to see in clinic. In order for Clinic Visit sheets to print, the scheduled appointment date must be entered into the study database. Therefore, it is necessary to check that all appointments scheduled in OUTLOOK have been entered into the Access database prior to printing the Clinic Visit sheets.

### **B.** Initial Interaction with Family at Clinic Visit

When families come in for a clinic visit it is important to greet them as they arrive and get them settled into the waiting area.

New families and families with a child who is antibody positive will have more questions and require more time on the part of the clinic staff.

## **D.** Collection of Biologic Samples at Clinic Visit

Urine sample if IVY

Update: Urine sample is only collected on AB+ subjects Sample is to be tested using ketodiastix for presence of glucose and ketones.

Blood: Venipuncture is preferred method for collection of samples: 30cc is typical blood draw. 10cc/kg is to be used as guideline in smaller children.

Blood will be tested for autoantibodies for type 1 diabetes and celiac disease.

#### **E. BIA Measurement**

Use TANITA Body Composition device to measure weight and percent body fat.

### Update 3/2019

Tg If CD Diagnosed –NO FURTHER Tg TESTING.

Communicate to participants that this part of the study is no longer active and they should be following up with their health care provider.

If Never Tg+, Never persistent Tg+ -NO FURTHER TESTING if/when over the age of 10 yrs.

If symptoms surface and/or there is a family history of CD and family requests, we will test-clinic staff should please WRITE ON THE CLINIC VISIT SHEET THAT FAMILY REQUESTS TG due to symptoms.

If currently or ever persistent Tg+ CONTINUE TESTING Tg, no matter what age.
