

Dear Parents,

Your child \_\_\_\_\_ had an OGTT, Oral Glucose Tolerance Test on \_\_\_\_\_.

The OGTT measures how much your blood sugar rises after drinking a sweet liquid. How high your blood sugar level rises depends on how much insulin your islet cells are able to release. The OGTT can be used to diagnose diabetes.

Your child's results were: Normal

- a. The fasting blood sugar is lower than 110
- b. The two-hour blood sugar is lower than 140

We recommend: repeating the OGTT in 6-12 months.
