The results for the DAISY antibody tests, drawn on 7/26/2011, are as follows:


GAA:	1	Negative	(GAD Autoantibody)
IAA:		Inconclusive	(Insulin Autoantibody)
IA-2:	0	Negative	(IA-2 Autoantibody)

This is a screening test to determine if antibodies to the pancreas are present. It is important to realize that even though the results suggest that there are no antibodies to the pancreas at this time, in the past you have been positive for one or more of the antibodies listed above. Due to this history we would like to continue to follow you more closely, and recommend repeating this test in six to twelve months.


