The results of the DAISY antibody tests for JANE, drawn on 5/9/2012, are as follows:

This is a screening test to determine if antibodies to the pancreas are present. These negative results suggest that there are no antibodies to the pancreas at this time. However, because your child has been positive for one or more of the antibodies listed above in the past, it is important to continue to follow your child over time. Therefore, we recommend repeating this test in six to twelve months.

We will be contacting you one month before JANE is due for his/her next clinic visit to schedule this appointment. In the meantime, please let us know if there are any changes in your family, such as a birth, the development of a disease or a change of address and phone number. This will help us to reach you when it is time to repeat the tests.
