The results of the DAISY Autoantibody tests for <u>name</u>, drawn on <u>date</u>, are as follows:

GAA:	25	Positive	(GAD Autoantibody)
IAA	-0.001	Negative	(Insulin Autoantibody)
IA-2:	0	Negative	(IA-2
ZnT8:	0.002	Negative	(ZnT8 Autoantibody)

This is a screening test to determine if Autoantibodies to the pancreas are present. It is important to realize that even though your child continues to be positive for one Autoantibody, it does not mean your child will definitely develop diabetes. 15 out of 100 individuals positive on this screening test will develop diabetes in their lifetime.

We would like to continue to follow your child more closely, and recommend repeating this test every three to six months. We will be contacting you one month before <u>name</u> is due for his/her next clinic visit to schedule this appointment.
