## I. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

The purpose of the Initiation of Dialysis Fax Notification Form (DIA) is to obtain dialysis initialization information on a participant from the site investigator. If you determine (either from the FUP or from the participant) that a participant is currently undergoing dialysis you must complete this form and fax it to the DCC.

Enter the participant identification number. Also, enter the contact occasion and sequence number of the follow-up contact form that indicated that the participant has initialized dialysis.

Participants who initiate dialysis continue the usual FAVORIT follow-up contacts until the DCC informs the Study Coordinator and the PI that the participant qualifies for post-event mortality surveillance. See manual of procedures, chapter 7 for more information on who qualifies for post-event mortality surveillance.

## II. SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Record the date that dialysis was initiated (for current dialysis).
- 2. Record whether the participant has developed dialysis-dependent end stage renal disease. This would be defined as a participant who will remain on dialysis for 3 months or longer or until a transplant is received.
- 3. The site investigator must sign this form to attest that the information is accurate.
- 3a. Print the name of the signature in item 3.
- 4. Record date of data collection.
