



## Autoimmune

### **GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS**

This form captures results from autoimmune tests performed on the patient. Results from historical tests should be recorded as well as any results from tests performed from the time of enrollment into the PALF Cohort Study through the 12 month follow-up period.

If autoimmune tests were never performed on the patient then the form does not have to be completed.

This form is in log format and each line should be completed as needed to record new information.

### **SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS**

Patient ID: Record the Patient ID

Autoimmune test: Select the autoimmune test performed:

ASMA: Anti-smooth muscle antibodies (also known as SMA, or smooth muscle antibodies); a test that detects the presence of antibodies against smooth muscle.

ANA: Antinuclear antibodies

ALKM: Anti-liver kidney microsome

pANCA: Perinuclear anti-neutrophil cytoplasmic antibodies

A-SLA: Anti-soluble liver antigen antibodies, quantitative determination of IgG antibodies against SLA in human serum.

IgG quant: Quantitative immunoglobulin test to measure the total amount of or specific level of IgG.

Sample date: Record the date that the sample was obtained for the test. The date is recorded in month/day/year format (2 digits). If any part of the date is unknown, enter -3 for the unknown part of the date and enter the other parts of the date that are known. If the entire date is unknown, check "Unknown".

Sample time: Record the time that the sample was drawn for the test. The time is recorded in 24-hour/military time (e.g. 00:00=midnight, 06:00=6 A.M., 12:00=noon, and 20:00=8 P.M.). If any part of the time is unknown, enter -3 for the unknown part of the time and enter the other parts of the time that are known. If the entire time is unknown, check "Unknown".

Result: Select the qualitative result of negative, positive, or not definitive. If the test results are pending, leave this column blank and complete this item when the results are known.

For any test that reports a quantitative result, record the quantitative result and indicate whether it is a titer, IU/units, or mg/dL. If a quantitative test was not performed, check "Not Done". If a quantitative test was performed but the result is not known, record -3 in the result field.

System ID: Record the system generated ID for the record.
