



GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

This form captures specific interventions performed/received from the time of the patient's initial hospitalization for this episode of ALF through the first outcome (hospital discharge, liver transplantation, death) or bone marrow transplantation.

If no interventions were performed/received then the form does not have to be completed.

This form is in log format and each line should be completed as needed to record new information.

If an intervention is temporarily interrupted and is immediately resumed following the interruption, consider the intervention as one intervention and complete one line on the log. If the intervention is intentionally interrupted to perform assessments to determine whether or not the intervention should be continued, consider the intervention as stopped and then started (more than one intervention) and complete a line of the log for each intervention.

If a **continuous intervention (e.g. CAVH)** is interrupted for more than 6 hours, consider the intervention as stopped and then started (more than one intervention) and complete one line of the log for each period of time that the intervention was given. If a continuous intervention is interrupted for 6 hours or less, consider the intervention as continuous (one intervention) and complete only one line of the log.

For Interventions that are given at one point in time (i.e., Vitamin K, rFactorVII, and rFactor VIIa) record the date and time that the intervention was given as both the date/time started and date/time stopped.

If an intervention is included in the list of interventions on this form and the medication reference library on the Medication Log, and is given as an intervention during the episode of ALF, the intervention should be recorded on this form and not on the Medication Log.

SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

Patient ID: Record the Patient ID

Intervention: Select the intervention from the list. The listing contains specific interventions of interest that the PALF investigators identified. If an intervention is given that is not on the list and the investigator feels that that type of intervention should be captured in the research database, please contact the DCC.

Enteral Feeding (34): the delivery of nutrients through a tube, including but not limited to a nasogastric tube (NG-tube, placed in the nose), gastric tube (G-tube, placed in the stomach), or jejunostomy tube (J-tube, placed in the small intestine).

Start Date: Record the date that the intervention started in month/day/year format (2 digits). If any part of the date is unknown, enter -3 for the unknown part of the date and enter the other parts of the date that are known. If the entire date is unknown, check "Unknown".

Start Time: Record the time that the intervention started in 24 hour, military time (midnight = 00:00, 8 p.m. = 20:00). If any part of the time is unknown, enter -3 for the unknown part of the time and enter the other parts of the time that are known. If the entire time is unknown, check "Unknown".



Intervention Log

- Stop Date:** Record the date that the intervention ended in month/day/year format (2 digits). If any part of the date is unknown, enter -3 for the unknown part of the date and enter the other parts of the date that are known. If the entire date is unknown, check "Unknown". If the intervention is ongoing at the time the patient meets an outcome, consent is withdrawn, or the patient undergoes a bone marrow transplant, enter -14 for the month, day, and year fields.
- Stop Time:** Record the time that the intervention ended in 24 hour, military time (midnight = 00:00, 8 p.m. = 20:00). If any part of the time is unknown, enter -3 for the unknown part of the time and enter the other parts of the time that are known. If the entire time is unknown, check "Unknown". If the intervention is ongoing at the time the patient meets an outcome, consent is withdrawn, or the the patient undergoes a bone marrow transplant, enter -14 for the hour and minute fields.
- Volume/amount given:** Enter the total volume or total amount given during the specified time frame for the interventions that require this information. Record the volume/amount in milliliters (ml, cc). If the total volume/amount given is unknown, record -3.
- Intervention specifics:** Enter the additional intervention information for the following:
- NAC (21): record the route that the NAC was given - IV (intravenous) or PO (oral).
 - Hypothermia (22): record the patient's most recent core temperature prior to the start of the intervention, in Celsius.
 - Intracranial monitoring (24): record the type of monitoring performed
 - Epidural: (a.k.a. subdural) sensor inserted between the skull and dural tissue.
 - Parenchymal: fiber-optic or wire.
 - Intraventricular: open-ended conduits placed directly into the ventricular CSF.
- System ID:** Record the system generated ID for the record.
