DATA SECTION	COMPLETION INSTRUCTIONS
GENERAL INFORMATION	The MATI-HepC was designed to educate the patient about chronic hepatitis C, about the study medications, how to manage the side effects of treatment, adherence, and use of the MEMS caps. The patient is provided with a diary to document the patient's medication schedule and any missed medication doses.

	<u>Section I, checklist items 1-9</u> : Check "Yes" if the activity was completed by the coordinator with the patient. If not, check "No".
DEPRESSION MANAGEMENT	GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:
	For Section IV, questions 1-3: Ask the patient the following questions regarding any depressive symptoms the patient may have since the last evaluation. Check "Yes" or "No" to indicate the patient's response. If the patient responds "Yes" to any of the questions, notify the Principal Investigator.
DAY 0 DOSE	SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS:
	<u>Ribavirin</u> : Record the date (month/day/year), time (military time), and total daily dose (mg) of ribavirin taken by the patient.
	Interferon: Record the date (month/day/year), time (military time), and total weekly dose ( $\mu$ g) of interferon taken by the patient.
INTERVIEW	<b>INTERVIEW GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:</b> Discuss each section with the patient using the outline provided. After each section is completed check the appropriate box in the checklist.
